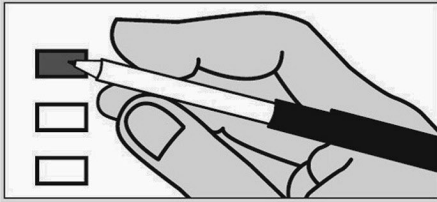

**JOINT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 3
(KUNA) SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY**

The Board of Trustees of Joint School District No. 3, Ada and Canyon Counties, State of Idaho, is seeking authorization to levy a Supplemental Levy for the following purposes and approximate amount of levy funds to be allocated to each use:

Purpose: Staffing and Operations
Maintenance
Amount: \$2,500,000

Purpose: Facility Maintenance
Amount: \$2,800,000

TOTAL ANNUAL LEVY AMOUNT:
\$5,300,000/year

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of Joint School District No. 3, Ada and Canyon Counties, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of Five Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,300,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026, for the purposes stated above; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on March 19, 2024?

The following information is required by Section 34-914, Idaho Code:

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$103.90 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.
